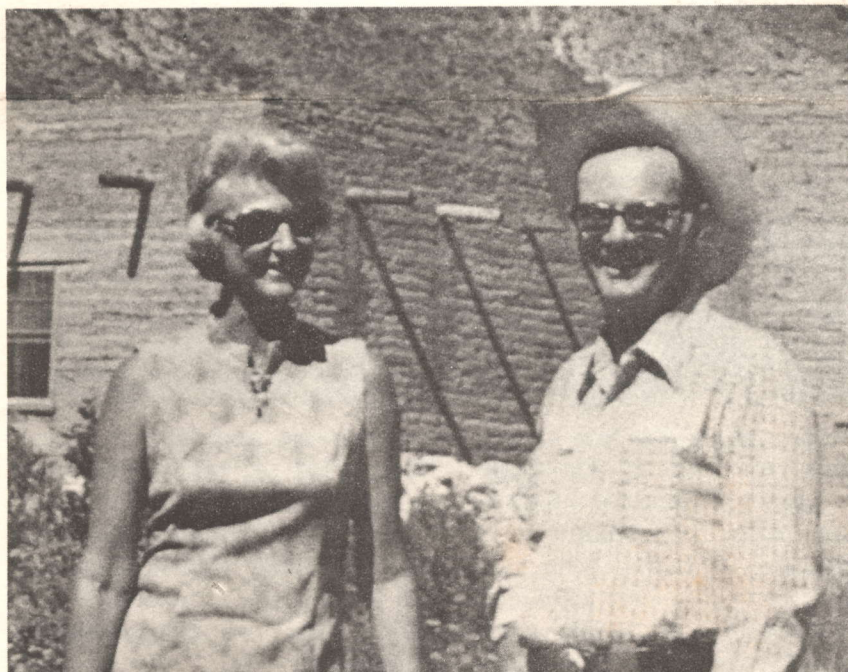


Jack North Moves East Richard Hines Moves Up

Terlingua Night Security

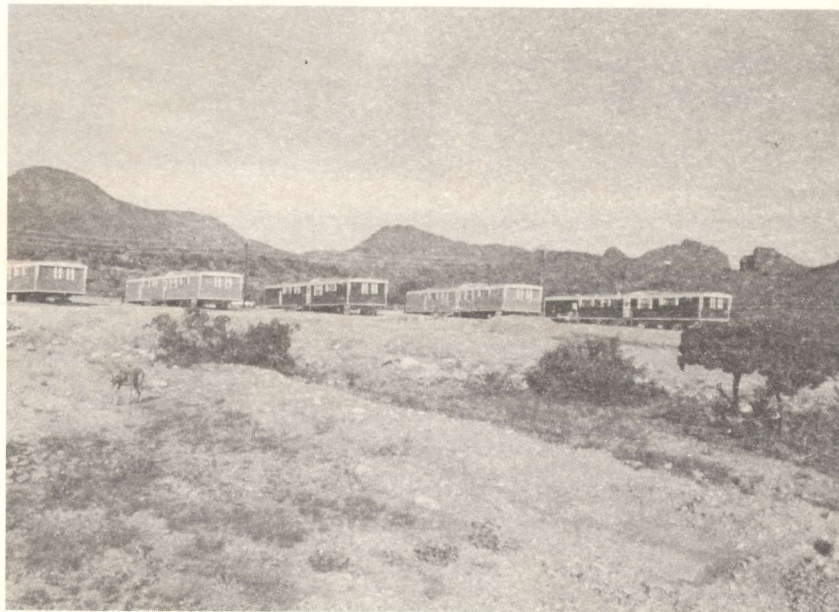
Gene Wise is now keeping an eye on Terlingua Ranch facilities as Night Security Patrolman; his duties include watching for fire and vandalism.
